Christmas Tree Recycling

Before recycling your tree, remove all tinsel and decorations. Unfortunately, flocked trees cannot be recycled, and are only accepted as trash for a fee at a landfill or transfer station, or you can cut and place them in your curbside trash cart (please, no sections longer than 3 feet).

Guidelines & Locations to Recycle Your Tree:

- Curbside customers in Cities of Anderson & Shasta Lake: Cut trees into sections that will fit inside your greenwaste cart. Full sized trees are not accepted curbside, and will not be picked up.
- Curbside customers in unincorporated county areas: Cut trees into sections no longer than 3 feet in length, and set next to your trash cart on collection day. Tree sections will be picked up for 2 weeks after Christmas. Full sized trees are not accepted curbside, and will not be picked up.
- Call Wheelabrator Shasta Energy Company in Anderson at 339-7600 to verify if facility is open and accepting trees.
- The City of Redding's Transfer Station accepts trees all year. Non-city residents pay a small fee, dependent on size. Call 224-6214.

Free Year-Round HHW Disposal

All Shasta County residents, including City of Anderson and City of Shasta Lake residents can bring household hazardous waste (HHW) to the City of Redding's HHWF at no charge. Business waste is not accepted.

Medication Disposal Event

Please do not flush prescription or over the counter medications down the drain or toilet, doing so can contaminate water and harm fish and wildlife. Medication may be disposed of in the trash or brought to the **City of Redding's "No Drugs Down the Drain" event, October 8th-10th from 9am-4pm.** Contact the City at 378-6701 about the event or Shasta County (225-5789) about tips to dispose of medication in the trash.

Tarps Required at Landfills & Transfer Stations

Vehicles transporting waste to transfer stations and landfills in Shasta County are required to place a tarp over all loads. Tarping loads helps prevent unsightly waste and litter along roadways. The vehicle code requires tarping, and loads that are not tarped may have to buy a tarp or pay an extra fee at solid waste facilities.

Anderson Leaf Pick-Up

In November & December the City of Anderson will conduct it's annual leaf pick-up. Homeowners are asked to make shared piles of loose leaves in front of their residences, but away from curbs and other obstructions. Pickup will be weekly and not always on the same day.
