FEE-EXEMPT NURSERY LICENSE INFORMATION SHEET

A nursery license from the California Department of Food and Agriculture is required to sell plants in California. Nurseries are normally charged a fee for these licenses. Because the fees for these licenses may present a burden to people just starting in the nursery business, or with very minimal plant sales, fee-exempt licenses may be obtained.

California Food and Agriculture Code, Division 4, Part 3, Chapter 1, Article 3, Section 6741 states:

A person is not required to pay any license fee if all of the following facts exist:

- (a) The person's sales of plants amount to less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) within any one fiscal year.
- (b) The person has reported to the commissioner his or her intention to make such sales.
- (c) All plants which are sold by the person are of his or her own production, and are sold for planting within the county in which the plants were grown.

We are providing this information to all people applying for fee-exempt status to help them decide whether they qualify for a Fee-Exempt Nursery License. The Shasta County Department of Agriculture may refuse, suspend, or revoke the license of anyone selling plants under a fee-exempt license who does not meet these conditions.

AFFIDAVIT

I do hereby certify that I have received and read the above Fee-Exempt Nursery License information prior to filling out my Fee-Exempt Nursery License application. I understand that I must be in compliance with all provisions of the California Food and Agriculture Code Section 6741 (a), (b), and (c) in order to qualify for a Fee-Exempt Nursery License. I understand that my Fee-Exempt Nursery License may be refused, suspended, or revoked if I am not in compliance with Section 6741.

NURSERY FACT SHEET

Nursery stock is no longer required to be labeled. But if it is labeled, it must comply with state law as summarized below.

LABELING REQUIREMENTS (Abbreviations Not Acceptable)

Indoor decorative plants No label required

Dormant bulbs, tubers, roots, corms,
rhizomes, pips Cultivar name*

Roses, annuals, herbaceous perennials Cultivar name

Fruit Trees Recognized common and cultivar name

Turf Kind and cultivar name**

All other ornamentals Genus and species (or
and cultivar)

*Recognized common name is required when cultivar name has been given or can be determined. Packages of mixed bulbs, tubers, corms, etc., may be labeled with "mixed" designations such as "Mixed Dahlias", "Mixed Gladiolas", and "Dahlias, Assorted".

**For blends and mixtures, the kinds and cultivars shown on the label of the seed lot planted should be shown.

DEAD, DYING, OR DAMAGED

Nursery stock shall not be dead or in a dying or seriously damaged condition when sold; nor shall it be abnormally pot bound.

PEST CLEANLINESS REQUIREMENTS

("Pest" includes weeds, insects, diseases and nematodes)

All nursery stock must be commercially clean with respect to common pests of general distribution, and free of pests which are not of general distribution. Fruit and nut trees, grapevine, berry, and vegetable plant nursery stock shall be free of nematodes or serious soil-borne diseases. Turf must be free of noxious, limited distribution, or other serious weeds.
