Approved agreements for residential treatment mental health services with Crestwood Behavioral Health, Inc. and with Helios Healthcare, LLC, d.b.a. Idylwood Care Center.

Adopted a resolution approving a renewal joint powers agreement with Caltrans for mailroom services.

Approved budget amendments in the HOME and Community Development Block Grant budgets.

Approved budget amendments in the Office of Emergency Services, Burney Substation, and Coroner budgets.

Approved a budget amendment in the Roads Administration budget.

Took various actions to purchase real property located at 1626 Court Street, Redding.

Approved a Notice of Completion for the Mental Health Building Roofing Project.
