SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS**

Tuesday, March 4, 2014

All Board Members were present.

The following routine items were considered by the Board of Supervisors and action was taken:

Made reappointments to the In-Home Supportive Services Advisory Committee.

Approved an agreement funding application with the CA Dept. of Public Health, Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health for services to protect and improve the health of mothers, adolescents, children, and their families as directed by state and federal law.

Took various actions for the Skylark Lane Emergency Fire Escape Road No. 2 Permanent Road Division (Palo Cedro area).

In addition, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions on their Regular Agenda:

Adopted a resolution which recognizes Shasta County's March 2014 Employee of the Month.

Adopted a proclamation designating March 2014 as Grand Jury Awareness Month

Approved a letter commenting on SB 848, *Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality, and Water Supply Act of 2014*, with suggested changes.

Approved a letter supporting AB 2703, *County veterans service officers*.

Reported on issues of countywide interest.
