Approved an agreement with Quick PC Support, LLC d.b.a. QPCS, LLC for a network infrastructure upgrade for mobile data computers.

Took various actions for the West Central Landfill Unit 4B Liner Repairs Project.

Approved an agreement with Darren Taylor Construction, Inc., for construction on the Platina Road Slide Repair Project.

Adopted a proclamation designating April 6-12, 2014 as Crime Victims' Rights Week.

Adopted a proclamation designating April 2014 as Child Abuse Prevention Awareness Month.
