All Board Members were present.

The following routine items were considered by the Board of Supervisors and action was taken:

Approved a budget transfer to the Probation AB 109 restricted account.

Appointed Betty Harrison-Smith to the Commission on Aging.

Approved agreements with BHC Heritage Oaks Hospital, Inc. and BHC Sierra Vista Hospital, Inc. for psychiatric inpatient hospitalization services.

Appointed Stevan Keyser to the Shasta County Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board.

Approved an agreement with the CA Dept. of Health Care Services to establish performance criteria for the provision of mental health services and allow access to certain resources and funds.

Approved an agreement with Western Business Equipment, Inc. d.b.a. Carrel's Office Machines for supplies and maintenance for a color digital imaging system.

In addition, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions on their Regular Agenda:

Adopted a proclamation designating October 2014 as Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

Adopted a proclamation designating October 2014 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month and October 16, 2014 as Think Pink Day.

Adopted a proclamation designating October 5-11, 2014 as Fire Prevention Week.

Reported on issues of countywide interest.
