SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS**

Tuesday, June 16, 2015

Supervisors Kehoe, Moty, Giacomini and Schappell were present.
Supervisor Baugh was absent.

The following routine items were considered by the Board of Supervisors and action was taken:

Approved a budget amendment for County Clerk-Elections for the Help America Vote Act Polling Place Accessibility Training Program.

Approved an agreement with West Publishing Corporation d.b.a. Westlaw to provide online legal research services to County Counsel's office.

Approved an agreement with Exam Works Clinical Solutions, LLC to provide Medicare Set Aside reporting services.

Approved an agreement with National Council on Crime and Delinquency for internet access to SafeMeasures, a child welfare data reporting service.

Adopted a resolution authorizing the Shasta County District Attorney to apply for funds from the California Department of Insurance for the operation of the Automobile Fraud Program.

Approved an agreement with Wright Education Services to provide community recidivism and crime reduction services for adult offenders.

Accepted the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant and approved a retroactive agreement with The CSU, Chico Research Foundation to develop a Local Evaluation Plan to evaluate the Shasta Reentry Reduction Program.

Approved a renewal agreement with the Shasta County Private Industry Council, d.b.a. SMART Business Resource Center to provide computerized inmate education services at the Shasta County Jail.

Adopted a resolution continuing proclamation of a local emergency due to drought conditions.

In addition, the Board of Supervisors took the following actions on their Regular Agenda:

Adopted a proclamation designating June 21, 2015 as The Longest Day and June 2015 as Alzheimer's and Brain Awareness Month in Shasta County.

Reported on issues of countywide interest.

Took various actions regarding the County's Child Welfare System Improvement Plan.
