

**ORDINANCE NO. SCC 2015-03**  
**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**OF THE COUNTY OF SHASTA**  
**AMENDING THE SHASTA COUNTY CODE SECTION 2.70.030**  
**REGARDING MEMBERSHIP IN THE**  
**PARTNERSHIP HEALTHPLAN OF CALIFORNIA COMMISSION**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Shasta ordains as follows:

**SECTION I.**

Section 2.70.030 of the Shasta County Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

**2.70.030 Membership of Commission**

- A. The Commission shall be comprised of Commissioners appointed by the Board of Supervisors of each member county. Unless and until the Commission, by formal action, establishes a different formula or system of membership, Commission representation for each member county shall be based on the number of Medi-Cal beneficiaries enrolled in the Commission's health care plan in each county as follows: one commissioner per zero to twenty-five thousand beneficiaries; two commissioners per twenty-five thousand to forty thousand beneficiaries; three commissioners per forty thousand to fifty-five thousand beneficiaries; and four commissioners per more than fifty-five thousand beneficiaries.
- B. The persons appointed to the Commission by the Shasta County Board of Supervisors shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors and shall be selected as follows:
- (1) One Commissioner shall be the Shasta County Health and Human Services Agency Director or his/her designee.
  - (2) Additional Commissioners shall be nominated by the Shasta Health Assessment & Redesign Collaborative (SHARC) and/or local health care providers that serve Medi-Cal beneficiaries.
- C. The Shasta County Health and Human Services Agency Director will receive and evaluate nominations and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors.

**SECTION II.**

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

**SECTION III.**


All former ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect 30 days after its passage. The Clerk shall cause this ordinance to be published as required by law.


