**BURGLARY SUSPECT FOUND GUILTY BY JURY**

On September 10, 2008, before visiting Judge Thomas Smith, a jury found Jason Lee Moore guilty of First Degree Residential Burglary. Judge Smith also found three enhancements true, that he committed this burglary while out on bail in another pending matter and that he had been previously committed to state prison on two separate occasions. Jason Moore along with a juvenile co-defendant broke into the home of the victims in the middle of the day and stole several thousands of dollars of property. The victims returned home while the burglary was taking place. A fourteen year old victim who lived at the residence was able to positively identify Jason Moore as the perpetrator of the burglary before he fled. Along with recorded jail conversations where Moore told his friend to hide the stolen property and the testimony of the juvenile co-defendant, the jury had no difficulty finding Moore guilty of burglary. Moore is facing another case against him for being a felon in possession of ammunition. That case is currently scheduled for a jury trial on October 21, 2008. The burglary case was investigated by Shasta County Sheriffs Investigator Mark Haslam. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Michael Hemker.
