MAN ARRESTED FOR STALKING FOUR WOMEN

Charles McKenzie, 42, of Redding, surrendered himself late last night and is being held in the Shasta County jail in lieu of \$510,000 bail for stalking four women. McKenzie is also being charged with violating his court ordered probation on a previous stalking case. McKenzie faces a maximum of 5 years in state prison.

It is alleged that McKenzie started his stalking activities towards the four charged victims, including two minor females, approximately five years ago. Further allegations are that McKenzie primarily targeted these women at their place of employment, primarily retail stores or businesses in shopping centers. The vehicle McKenzie is alleged to have primarily used is described as a blue F350 Ford Pickup 4x4 with distinctive yellow, red and black paint strips on all four doors.

McKenzie is set to be arraigned today in Shasta County Superior Court Department 2 at 1:30 p.m.
