**7<sup>th</sup> Annual National Domestic Violence Apprehension Detail Local Results**

On 10/15/09, the Shasta County District Attorney's Office and members of the Shasta County Sheriff's Office, Shasta County Probation Department, Redding Police Department, Anderson Police Department, Marshall's Office, California Highway Patrol, and the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, Division of Adult Parole Operations, Redding Parole Unit, jointly participated in a nationwide warrant sweep to arrest domestic violence offenders. The event is part of the domestic violence awareness month activities in Shasta County.

The nationwide event is called the National Family Violence Apprehension Detail. This is the 7<sup>th</sup> annual warrant sweep all of which have been coordinated by the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office Domestic Violence Enhanced Response Team (DVERT) in Clackamas County, Oregon. This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> year Shasta County has participated and was led by the Shasta County District Attorney's office.

This year's Shasta County effort involved 37 law enforcement, probation, and parole officers throughout the county arresting defendants with outstanding arrest warrants for domestic violence offenses. The warrants served consisted of felony and misdemeanor cases. 10 subjects were arrested and 12 warrants were served.

Once nationwide totals are counted, Clackamas County Sheriff's Office DVERT will make available the final results of the national apprehension detail.
