Child Molestation Defendant Sentenced to Thirteen Years in Prison

On October 14, 2011, Honorable Gregory Gaul sentenced Jason Edgar Hall to a maximum sentence of thirteen years four months prison for molesting two victims. This follows a guilty verdict from a jury trial that concluded September 2, 2011.

Between 2003 and 2007, Hall molested his stepdaughter. In 2010, Hall sexually assaulted a friend of the stepdaughter at a birthday party. These events led to the filing of six felony counts involving sexual misconduct. Hall must serve 85% of his sentence and register as a sex offender for the remainder of his life.

This case was investigated by the Shasta County Sheriff's office, the Redding Police Department, and the Shasta County District Attorney's Investigations division. The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Michael Hemker.
