**REDDING MAN FOUND GUILTY OF LEWD AND LASCIVIOUS ACTS ON
CHILD**

Redding – Today Adam Lee Burke, age 32, was found guilty by a Shasta County jury of four felony counts of Lewd and Lascivious Acts on a child under the age of 14 years. The jury's verdict came after two days of testimony in a trial that started two weeks ago. The female victim was eight years old at the time of the molestation. The molestation occurred while the victim was attending a sleepover at the defendant's house in Redding during June 2010. Burke was on parole at the time of the molestation.

The defendant is facing 16 years in state prison for this offense. The defendant must serve 85 percent of the sentence before he would be eligible for parole.

A judgment and sentencing date will be set this coming Monday.

The case was investigated by Kristen Fredrick of the Redding Police Department and prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Curtis Woods. Debra Heide of the Crime Victims Assistance Center assisted the victim.
