**CRIME SPREE CATCHES UP TO REDDING MAN WHO IS NOW  
HEADED TO STATE PRISON**

Redding – On Tuesday, Redding resident Randall Markwith pleaded guilty to First Degree Residential Burglary that was committed on March 28, 2013. Markwith was pending sentencing at the time for cases involving the Transportation of Methamphetamine and Possession of Stolen Property. Markwith was out of custody pending sentencing, which would have been pursuant to AB 109, on the Transportation of Methamphetamine and Possession of Stolen Property cases, when he committed the Residential Burglary on March 28th. Markwith was also on felony Proposition 36 probation at the time of these new crimes.

The defendant will be sentence to 5 years in state prison for these offenses, and the Residential Burglary will constitute a “Strike” offense for any future felony conviction that may be committed by the defendant. Judgment and sentencing will be May 16th.

The case was investigated by officers from the Redding Police Department and prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Curtis Woods.
