**CONVICTED RAPIST SENTENCED TO 18 YEARS 8 MONTHS IN STATE
PRISON**

Today, Shasta County Judge Monica Marlow sentenced Terry Lee Crosley, 48, to 18 years and 8 months in state prison for forcible rape, criminal threats and domestic violence.

On February 22, 2013, a Shasta County jury found Crosley guilty of forcible rape, criminal threats and battery against a former spouse. Evidence at the three week trial showed that during the late evening hours of November 18, 2010, Terry Lee Crosley raped the victim outside of her home. During the rape, Crosley threatened to kill the victim and told the victim this would be the last time ever. Crosley told the victim during the assault and rape that she needed to die for the pain to stop. Crosley and the victim were married during the 1990s but divorced sometime in 1999.

The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Sarah Van Slyke and investigated by Investigator Kristen Blehm of the Shasta County District Attorney's Office and Investigator Daniel Smetak of the Redding Police Department.
