**TRINITY COUNTY UNDERSHERIFF CHARGED
WITH HIT-AND-RUN DRIVING**

Today, the Shasta County District Attorney's Office has filed a single count alleging a misdemeanor violation of Vehicle Code Section 20002(a), Hit-and-Run Driving, against Kenneth Arthur Langston, the Undersheriff of Trinity County. The charge arises from a solo vehicle traffic collision that occurred on January 7 of this year in which City of Redding property was damaged. Redding Police Department officers responded to find the vehicle involved in the collision abandoned at the scene. The subsequent investigation tied Langston to the collision. The date for his arraignment in court has not yet been determined. If convicted of the charge, Langston faces a maximum punishment of six months in county jail and a \$1000 fine.

The case was investigated by the Redding Police Department and Investigator Kristen Blehm of the Shasta County District Attorney's Office.
