Man Convicted of Multiple Counts of Assault with a Deadly Weapon

Jimmie Lee Jones was convicted by jury today of four felony counts of Assault with a Deadly Weapon, one felony count of Criminal Threats, one felony count of Corporal Injury to a Cohabitant, one felony count of Attempted Corporal Injury to a Cohabitant, and one misdemeanor count of Hit and Run. The jury found a special allegation of Domestic Violence with Great Bodily Injury to be true.

The defendant hit his live-in girlfriend on April 30, 2015, with a baseball bat in the leg, threatened to kill her, and then stabbed her in the arm with a pitch fork. On May 2, 2015, the defendant located the victim parked in the driver's seat of a vehicle. He hit the victim multiple times in the face and head and tried to physically remove her from the vehicle through the window. The defendant then returned to his vehicle, backed up, and accelerated at full speed, ramming the driver's side door where the victim was sitting.

The eight day trial concluded yesterday and the jury returned the verdicts after approximately six hours of deliberation. The defendant is facing a life sentence in state prison for these crimes. His sentencing is scheduled for April 15, 2016 with the Honorable Judge Gregory Gaul.
