**“SHASTA COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY’S INVESTIGATORS
ARREST ONE OF SHASTA COUNTY’S “MOST WANTED”**

On Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at 10:24am, investigators with the Shasta County District Attorney’s Office responded to the 15000 block of Fawndale Road in Redding. Investigator Scarry and Investigator Magleby contacted one of “Shasta County’s Most Wanted” fugitives, Robert Raymond Luis Arevalo, 41 years old, at the location. Robert Arevalo had two outstanding felony warrants for his arrest that were issued as a result of two separate crimes of domestic violence. The warrants for Arevalo had been outstanding since August 2016. Arevalo was on probation for the crimes and his probation had been revoked. Arevalo’s total bail on the two warrants was set at \$200,000. Arevalo has a lengthy prior criminal history, consisting of numerous violent crimes, to include: Aggravated assault and battery/attempt to injure with a weapon; felony domestic violence; felony driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs; and prior probation violations. Arevalo was booked into the Shasta County Jail without further incident.

Chief Deputy District Attorney Stephanie Bridgett said, “This is a fine example of the dedication of our Bureau of Investigations and their daily efforts to help keep the citizens of Shasta County safe.”
