California and Local Tobacco Laws

- It is against the law to smoke and use Electronic Smoking Devices in the following areas:
 - places of employment
 - within 20 feet of entrances, exits, and operable windows of State, County, or City owned buildings
 - all park facilities, city hall, and library in the City of Redding
 - all community events and selected parks in the City of Anderson
 - within 20 feet of entrances, exits, operable windows, and ventilation units of business in the City of Anderson
 - Whiskeytown National Recreation Area except personal cars and boats
 - daycare centers, restaurants, and bars
 - public transportation
 - elementary, middle, and secondary schools
 - within 25 feet of a playground or tot lot area
 - within 20 feet of stadium seating
 - indoor common areas of multi-unit housing
 - vehicles when children are present
- It is against the law for anyone to sell, give, or in any way furnish to a youth under 21 any tobacco product.
