The California Children's Services Program

Clients range in age from birth to age 21. Children who are part of the CCS family



have serious medical conditions. The CCS program assists, directs, and pays for medical expenses when families are unable to pay for all or part of their care. Families do have to be financially and medically eligible to be in the CCS Program.

Medical issues such as cerebral palsy, cystic fibrosis, spina bifida, blindness, cancer, diabetes and many other physically and medically disabling conditions are just part of CCS' clientele.

Raising a child with such special needs is very stressful and demanding. Our **Family Donation Fund** is used to support education and activities that aid and assist clients and their families to achieve their best.



The Family Donation Fund supports a variety of different programs. Listed below are a few of the programs we support but are not limited to:

Challenger's Little League and Tops Soccer

Challenger's Little League takes place each spring. Our Family Donation

Fund helps sponsor one team for the season. More than 70 local children participate. Games take



place at the Shasta Dam Little League Fields.

Each player is provided a team t-shirt and hat. At the end of the season, players participate in a short tournament, receive a trophy and enjoy a family BBQ. The Family Donation Fund also helps support our local soccer team. **Tops Soccer** plays in the fall, and games are usually in Anderson. Each player gets a jersey and receives a trophy at the end of the year.

Trainings

The Family Donation Fund can help parents offset fees to local trainings that provide beneficial information to families in respect to their child's needs.



Holiday Party

Each year California Children's Services hosts a holiday party. More than 50 children and their

families normally attend.

Each child receives a gift from Santa chosen



especially for them. There are lots of crafts, face painting and music to enjoy. Many families like visiting with each other while enjoying snacks and refreshments.

Lending Library

The CCS Lending Library has a variety of books that address medical, social, and educational issues that can affect many of



our families. Many of these books and videos are not in our local bookstore. It helps parents to have access to resources and information that can assist them in their daily life.
