Their door-to-door service enables customers to continue daily activities such as shopping, medical appointments, use of senior dining facilities or simply visit a friend.






Going to the Coast? Transfer in Weaverville on Trinity Transit



Going to Sacramento/Sac Airport?

Catch First Class Shuttle down to the Sacramento Airport at the Redding Oxford Suites on Hilltop Drive or at the Redding Downtown Transit Center. Stops in Red Bluff, Corning, Orland, and Willows are also available upon request. Fare between Redding and Sacramento Airport: \$65 (One-Way), \$110 (Round Trip). Fuel surcharges may apply. At the Airport travelers can also connect with YOLO Bus to continue to Sacramento. Discounted group rates are available.
