Financial Report

Action Items

Vivitrol - HHSA is working with County Counsel on a three-party contract to include Shasta County Probation/HHSA, Empire Recovery and Shasta Community Health Center. The contract will need to go to the Board of Supervisors for approval. A referral will be made at the time of assessment by a HHSA staff member.

Compliance Team - An alternate team concept was presented and discussed.

Discussion Items

The upcoming Realignment Conference was discussed.

There was general discussion regarding data collection: What are we trying to report? How can we measure our successes? Where are our successes? What are key indicators to measure success? Show different aspects of overall crime problem; Breakdown FTA according to various appearances; Make contact with other statewide committees. Penny Mossman will work toward reorganizing the data committee. Donnell Ewert will help provide direction for the committee.

#### Operational Updates

There was general discussion regarding vocational training, Shasta College programs, SMART Center, and ongoing GED program at the jail.

The Requests for Proposal for supportive housing have been submitted. North Valley Catholic Social Services seems to be the best. Negotiations are taking place.

The Supervised OR Program process and the forms, reports, etc., need to be approved by the judges.

The GPS contract is still with BI for review.

The Sheriff's Office and the Probation Department hiring process is ongoing.

A number of contracts are pending.
