**Meeting Overview:**

The meeting was called to order at 3:10 p.m. Introductions were made.

Public Comment

Wes Forman took this opportunity to state that if there was a recommendation to include a Division Manager for Probation in the Plan, he would not oppose it.

Meeting Minutes

Meeting Minutes of May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 30<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup>, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012 were discussed, amended and approved.

Financial

Julie Hope distributed revenue handouts and copies of a realignment related board report that went to the Board of Supervisors on June 19<sup>th</sup>. There was general discussion of the information in the revenue handout. The Board report requested approval of a resolution and fiscal year-end technical budget adjustments to continue to implement the Shasta County Public Safety Realignment Plan. The sunset dates of the positions in the plan were adjusted to sunset 6/30/13. Susan Wilson will adjust the 2012 Plan to reflect the financial data from the board report

Presentation

Consultant Jessica Delaney presented a preliminary report on developing a plan to address the supportive housing needs of the realignment offender population. Jessica has 15 years of direct service with the homeless population, and is now working with the Homeless Continuum of Care. Jessica

distributed a timeline for developing a plan, a draft of Homeless Definitions of the Shasta County Offenders on post release community supervision, and a *Housing California: Report*. Some minor adjustments were made to the timeline. There was general discussion regarding the definition of homelessness. Chelsey and Jessica are working together to plan several one-hour sessions for parolees to determine what services are needed. Jessica will move forward on developing the plan.

#### Action Items

- a. Review, edit and approve the Shasta County Public Safety 2012 Realignment Plan. A meeting to work on the Plan was scheduled for June 25<sup>th</sup> at 1:30.
- b. Consider a decision to support, in concept, a commitment to a new Shasta County jail. This item was tabled for future meetings.
- c. Discuss and approve agenda items for the CCP Advisory Committee meeting 7/11/12. A revenue report and the 2012/13 proposed budget for the Plan will be presented. An overview of Executive Committee actions will be presented. Committee members will provide program progress, updates, and impacts, along with plans for future action.

Suggestions were made to invite speakers from Simpson and Shasta College, and various employment and vocational services providers to address the Committee.

The next regularly scheduled CCPEC meeting has been rescheduled for 3:00, on July 25, 2012, in the Public Safety Conference Room, located at 1525 Court Street.
