Meeting Overview:

Meeting was called to order at 3:15 p.m. and a quorum was not present. Members in attendance chose to proceed to general discussion items.

Financial Report

Julie Hope distributed a FY 12/13 Revenue report. Julie stated that revenue is on target.

Gayle Hermann distributed a CCP Planning Grant Budget and stated there is a remaining balance of \$119,684.58. Gayle also distributed an AB 109 Training and Implementation Budget and stated the balance of the one-time money is \$45,963.15.

Action Items

- A. The revised version of the Shasta County Public Safety Realignment Plan was not discussed.
- B. Penny Mossman distributed a handout and explained how the Employment Task Force Committee was formed and introduced Melissa Janulewicz as the facilitator of the meetings. There was general discussion about the committee's recommendations to the CCP Executive Committee. We asked that any recommendations to the committee have a cost included.

There was no action taken

### Discussion items

- A. Penny gave an update on the Supervised Own Recognizance (SOR) program. She stated there were currently 22 offenders on the program with six successful completions since March.
- B. Penny gave an update on the Community Corrections Center (CCC) and Day Reporting Center (DRC). The CCC has begun group orientation and the Employment Training Worker (ETW) was working part time at the CCC. The DRC currently has 25 clients.
- C. Penny indicated that the PATH housing assistance program is “on line” and they are doing orientation and training.

### Operational Updates

- A. Melissa Fowler-Bradley talked about the number of offenders who fail to appear at sentencing.
- B. Matt Mitchell explained that he oversees the SOR program at the jail.
- C. Dean True stated the Vivitrol Program is going well with six offenders participating.

### Other Items for Discussion/Future Agenda Items

The next meeting will be June 19, 2013.

There were no additional discussion items or operational updates.
