The Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA) Annual Progress Report to be submitted to the BSCC by October 15, 2013, was reviewed. Discussion followed. Recommendations were to

Rob Paoletti moved to approve the reports with expanded narratives; Tim Pappas seconded; motion passed with 8 Ayes, 0 Noes, 1 Abstention. Tom Bosenko abstained due to arriving late and not being involved in the discussion.

Tim Pappas stated that due to the successes and the demonstrated positive impact of The Parent Project program, the Council should consider expanding the program in the future and allocating increased funding. The program teaches parents to be parents; he believes it is money well spent.

Susan Wilson expressed agreement with those comments and offered her own comments in support of parenting programs in general.

Tom Bosenko offered his comments about the success of parenting classes in the jail.

General discussion of parenting programs followed and members expressed a desire to attend future Parent Project graduations.
