

Mandatory Business/Multi-Family Recycling

What is it?

Starting July 1st, 2012, the State of California will require businesses, public entities, and multifamily complexes to participate in a recycling program. (CA State Legislation AB 341)

Who needs to Comply?

- Businesses that generate 4 or more cubic yards of trash per week
- Multi-Family dwellings with 5 or more units (i.e. apartment complexes, trailer parks, etc.)
- Public Entities that generate 4 or more cubic yards of trash per week (Government offices, Schools, etc.)

How to Comply?

The regulation can be met by a combination of the following:

- Self-haul to a recycling facility
- Subscribe to curbside service in your area (contact your waste hauler for availability)
- Arrange for pick-up of recyclables.

What types of material need to be recycled?



- Clean, dry paper
- Cardboard and chipboard
- Plastic and glass bottles and jars
- Metal and aluminum cans
- Metal containers and empty aerosol cans
- Plastic bags & dry cleaners bags bundled
