July 1, 2016 through August 15, 2016**

A Hazard Mitigation Plan is a pre-disaster strategic plan to help guide a community on how to lower its risk and exposure to disaster. The objectives of the plan are to minimize the risk of wildfire, flood, and other natural and non-natural disasters, to provide for personal safety, minimize property loss, and to incorporate projects that could reduce risk.

FEMA regulations require that the plan must be updated every five years. The update includes input from the community on what hazards are most evident and critical to landowners and residents. Comments must be received by 5:00 p.m. on August 15, 2016.
