Green Waste & Christmas Tree Recycling

Before recycling your tree, remove all tinsel and decorations.

Unfortunately, flocked trees cannot be recycled, and are only accepted as trash for a fee at a landfill or transfer station, or you can cut and place them in your curbside trash cart (please, no sections longer than 3 feet).

Guidelines & Locations to Recycle Your Tree:

- Waste Management Curbside customers in Cities of Anderson & Shasta Lake: Cut trees into sections that will fit inside your green waste cart. Full-sized trees are not accepted curbside, and will not be picked up.
- Curbside customers in unincorporated county areas serviced by Waste Management: Cut trees into sections no longer than 3 feet in length, and set next to your trash cart on collection day. Tree sections will be picked up for 2 weeks after Christmas. Full-sized trees are not accepted curbside, and will not be picked up.
- Call Wheelabrator Shasta Energy Company in Anderson at 339-7600 to verify if facility is open and accepting trees.
- The City of Redding's Transfer Station accepts trees all year. Non-city residents pay a small fee, dependent on size. Call 224-6201 for more information.



These can be reused, or you can recycle them at most grocery stores. Consider reusable bags if you have an abundance of plastic bags.

Anderson Leaf Pick-Up

As the fall and winter weather arrives and the leaves fall from the trees, the City of Anderson wishes to remind its residents to place their leaves in the Green Waste carts. In addition to residents using their Green Waste carts, residents may, if needed, make shared piles of loose leaves in front of their residences, but away from curbs and other obstructions. Proper Tire Care & Safety¹



The Rubber Manufacturers Association (RMA) recommends getting in the habit of taking five minutes every month to check your tires, including the spare. If you think you may have a tire problem or are unsure of the condition of your tires, consult a tire dealer.

PRESSURE. Underinflation is a tire's #1 Enemy. A tire can lose up to half of its air pressure and not appear to be flat!

ALIGNMENT. Is your vehicle pulling to one side, or shaking? A bad jolt from hitting a curb or pothole can throw your front end out of alignment and damage your tires.

ROTATION. Promotes uniform tire wear. Regularly rotating your vehicle's tires will help you achieve more uniform wear.

TREAD. Measure it -- and inspect it. Visually check your tires for uneven wear, looking for high and low areas or unusually smooth areas. Also check for signs of damage.
