

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BY THE  
SHASTA COUNTY AIRPORT LAND USE COMMISSION**

This notice is being sent to property owners within or near the area shown on the attached map and to all applicable public agencies. **Airport Land Use Commission 16-001** is located in the east Redding area located on the site of the Redding Municipal Airport west of Airport Road and bounded on the north by Rancho Road and to the south by Fig Tree Lane. **The City of Redding** is requesting a finding of consistency for the Redding Municipal Airport Master Plan. Staff Planner. Lozier.



The Shasta County Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) will hold a public hearing on whether this project is consistent with the Redding Municipal Airport Comprehensive Land Use Plan (airport compatibility plan). The ALUC review of this project has been determined to not be subject to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act. The public hearing to consider the project will be held on **Thursday, June 2, 2016 with the session beginning at 2:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as the business of the ALUC will allow. The hearing will be held at the Board of Supervisors' Chambers located in the Shasta County Administration Center at 1450 Court Street, Room 263, Redding, CA.

You are encouraged to submit written comments before the hearing, or to attend and speak at the hearing. To ensure consideration by the Airport Land Use Commission, all written material concerning the proposed project should be submitted to the Planning Division as soon as possible and no later than three days prior to the hearing. Persons wishing to submit comments or appear before the ALUC Commission are encouraged to first contact the staff planner listed for the project.

Please note that if you challenge the action of the ALUC or project proponent in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the ALUC at, or prior to, the public hearing.
