- Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA): IS-100.HC Introduction to the Incident Command System for Healthcare/Hospitals. This course provides self-paced and guided introduction to ICS geared to healthcare providers. This course is accredited by the National Integration Center (NIC) and fulfills the mandatory training requirements.
