SUBJECT: Zogg Fire - Disaster Relief

The following information concerning property assessments is provided to you for dissemination to the public. We would appreciate your using it in your media at your earliest convenience.

Leslie Morgan, Shasta County Assessor-Recorder, would like to inform property owners who have lost or sustained damage to their property as a result of the Zogg fire in Shasta County that they may be eligible for a reduction in the assessed value of their property.

The Assessor's office will be working with Cal Fire to get out to the burned area in the coming weeks so that we can update your records, enroll corrections, and track your protected base year values. Please utilize the appraisers for any of your questions, as they will be contacting all of the property owners as they review the files.

Those individuals who have suffered fire damage are encouraged to contact the Assessor's Office at 225-3600 and obtain a "Claim for Disaster Relief" application or visit our website at: http://www.co.shasta.ca.us/index/assessor_index/assessor_forms.aspx to print the form. This claim for reassessment should be filed with the Assessor within 60 days of the date of damage to the property.

In order to update a mailing address for assessment and property tax purposes, a property owner needs to notify the Assessor's office in writing of the new address. An address change form can be downloaded from the Assessor's office website, filled out at the Assessor's office front counter or one can be mailed to a temporary address.

Those individuals who lost vital records such as Birth, Death and Marriage certificates in the Zogg fire may be eligible to obtain a replacement free of charge. Contact the Recorder's office for more information at (530) 225-5671.
