Rise in COVID-19 cases to alter County services

Due to high levels of community transmission of COVID-19, including some County Departments considered to be in an “outbreak status”, the County of Shasta will limit in-person services until further notice. County Departments are making the effort to have employees work remotely as much as possible. The County is currently seeing the highest number of COVID positive staff members to date. All essential services remain in operation.

County residents are encouraged to check online or contact County Departments by telephone prior to visiting County offices. Some services will be available by appointment only.
