The Shasta County District Attorney's Office is conducting a criminal investigation related to the Zogg Fire. As part of the investigation, we are also looking into the injuries and deaths sustained by domestic livestock and household pets. If you do not have any domestic livestock or pets that were injured during the Zogg Fire, there is no need for any further action on your part.

This letter serves as a formal request for information surrounding the health and wellbeing of your pet(s) during and following the Zogg Fire incident. We request to be notified of the species and number of animals injured by the Zogg Fire. We request the name(s) of your animal(s), the extent of their injuries, whether your animal(s) was seen by a veterinary service, receipt(s) for service, and any other information relevant to the investigation surrounding the health of your animal(s).

Please fill out the form included with this letter and mail it to or drop it off with the Shasta County District Attorney's Office. You may also access an electronic, fillable form in which to submit your report on the Shasta County District Attorney's website at <https://www.co.shasta.ca.us/index/da>. The form is located on the District Attorney's home page. You can click on *Zogg Fire Animal Report Form*. Use the *Submit* feature at the bottom of the form to send it electronically to our office.
