

Dear Judge Flynn:

First and foremost, the City of Anderson City Council would like to thank you and the Grand Jurors for all of the time and energy put forth in creating the 2018- 2019 Grand Jury Report. The hard work of all involved is greatly appreciated.

This correspondence is to address the report entitled "911: What's Your Emergency," which focuses on the SHASCOM Operations. Within that report, the Grand Jury requested that the City of Anderson respond to findings and recommendations of the Grand Jury. The City of Anderson does not agree that it is required to respond to the findings and recommendations, and through this letter, declines to respond. Pursuant to Penal Code Section 933, "A final report may be submitted for comment to **responsible** officers, agencies, or departments..." (Emphasis added.) In this case, SHASCOM is the responsible agency, as it is a separate legal entity under the Joint Exercise of Powers Act set forth in Government Code Section 6500 et seq. SHASCOM was created through a joint powers agreement, which formed the entity as a separate body with its own Board of Directors. Those Board of Directors govern SHASCOM, and are responsible for its operations.

In effect, the Anderson City Council is not the governing body of SHASCOM and has no authority or responsibility over that agency. As such, the City of Anderson City Council is not required to respond to the findings and recommendations of the Grand Jury, and hereby declines to respond.
