CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have no new positive cases today, and six more people have recovered. Starting today, we are reporting the number of people who are currently hospitalized with COVID-19 and the total number of patients who have been in the hospital (total of current and released). More testing is now available in Shasta County. People who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath) should contact their healthcare provider to request a test. People who have symptoms but don't have a healthcare provider or are having trouble getting a test, call Shasta County Public Health at (530) 225-5591. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Shasta County is looking to hire more people to work in the Federal Medical Station (FMS) and other assignments.
