The patient is a teenage girl who is isolated at home.</li> <li><b>More testing is now available in Shasta County.</b> People who are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath) should contact their healthcare provider to be tested. Those who don't have a healthcare provider or are having trouble getting a test should <b>call Shasta County Public Health at (530) 225-5591</b> so they can be screened and scheduled for mobile testing.</li> </ul>
