Situation Summary:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have 4 new cases today. All had symptoms and none are hospitalized. They are a woman in her 20s, a woman in her 30s, a woman in her 50s and a man in his 50s. We added 4 cases today but our total only increased by 3 because it was determined that a man in his 40s recently added to the list lives in another county. Today, Gov. Gavin Newsom announced new statewide closures effective immediately: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> CLOSED EVERYWHERE IN CALIFORNIA: Indoor service in dine-in restaurants, wineries and tasting rooms, movie theaters, family entertainment centers, zoos, museums and cardrooms. Bars must close all operations. CLOSED IN COUNTIES ON THE STATE WATCH LIST ONLY, WHICH DOES NOT INCLUDE SHASTA: Indoor operations in fitness centers, places of worship, offices for non-critical sectors, personal care services, hair salons and barbershops, malls.
