CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We have eight new cases today. Seven had symptoms and one is hospitalized. They are a man in his 30s, two men in their 40s, a man in his 50s, two men in their 60s, a man in his 80s and a woman in her 80s. About the numbers: Total confirmed cases are those who have tested positive with a nasal swab test (not an antibody test), and each number represents a unique individual. Deaths are only included in these numbers if COVID contributed to the person’s death. If someone were COVID positive and died of something unrelated, such as a car accident, that person would not be included as a COVID-related death. Anyone can be tested for COVID-19, with or without symptoms. Go to www.ShastaReady.org and click on “Get tested” to determine the best option for you.
