### CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 3 new cases on Wednesday. All had symptoms, and none are hospitalized. They are:
  - A woman in her 20s
  - A man in his 40s
  - A woman in her 70s
- A simple piece of fabric makes a big statement: I care. Even without symptoms, you can spread COVID-19. Cloth face coverings keep respiratory droplets contained when you speak, sneeze or cough. We can all do our part by wearing a mask and slowing the spread. If we keep our case numbers low, we will stay off the state’s monitoring list, which will allow us to keep our schools and businesses open.
