CURRENT SITUATION	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We had a total of 14 new cases on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Twelve had symptoms and none are hospitalized. They are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Two teenage girls and one teenage boy One woman and one man in their 20s One man in his 30s One woman and one man in their 40s One woman and two men in their 50s One woman and two men in their 60s * Negative test numbers were not available today. Myth: “Sick people can just stay home.” Fact: Some of our cases, including several who required hospitalization, were high-risk people who were staying home and contracted the virus from someone living in their household. COVID-19 can be contagious before a person has symptoms, so it’s very important for people to wear face coverings and practice physical distancing in public to avoid spreading the disease. By the numbers: The majority of COVID-19 cases in Shasta County continue to be among adults 18-39, followed by adults 40-54.
