CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 26 new cases on Thursday. Twenty-five had symptoms and two are hospitalized. They are:
 - One girl under age 13
 - Three teenage girls and one teenage boy
 - Five women and one man in their 20s
 - Three women and three men in their 30s
 - Two women and one man in their 40s
 - One woman in her 50s
 - One woman and two men in their 60s
 - One woman in her 70s
 - One woman in her 80s
- We are sorry to have to report two deaths today. They are a woman in her 80s and a woman in her 60s.
- Our weekly livestreamed briefing was on hold this week due to the Zogg Fire. It will resume at **11:30 a.m.** on Wednesday, Oct. 7, as we anticipate that we will be moved into the red (“substantial”) tier of the state’s Blueprint for a Safer Economy late next week. We will have additional information to share about that, along with an update on our current efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19 in our community.
