CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 40 new cases on Thursday, including 14 men and 26 women. They are:
 - 2 children under 13
 - 4 teenagers
 - 13 people in their 20s
 - 3 people in their 30s
 - 7 people in their 40s
 - 7 people in their 50s
 - 1 person in their 60s
 - 1 person in their 80s
 - 2 people older than 89

Our testing systems are very busy due to the recent increase in cases, so if you have symptoms or have been exposed to a positive case and you cannot be tested for several days, please stay home and away from other people until you are able to get tested and receive your results. **Please do not go to a hospital emergency department to be tested for COVID-19.** The emergency departments are available for medical emergencies.
