### CURRENT SITUATION

- We had 30 new cases on Thursday, including 12 men and 18 women. They are:
  - 2 children under age 13
  - 1 teenager
  - 4 people in their 20s
  - 11 people in their 30s
  - 3 people in their 40s
  - 3 people in their 50s
  - 4 people in their 60s
  - 1 person in their 70s
  - 1 person over age 89
- We are sorry to have to report a death today. The patient was a man in his 80s.
- The state has updated its schools guidance to [allow outdoor singing and band practice](#), provided that physical distancing and mask wearing are implemented to the maximum extent possible. Playing of wind instruments is still strongly discouraged.
