

Triple P Dashboard Report December 2013 Data Submission

The source data for this report is from the Shasta County Scoring Application as entered by Triple P providers and does not include data received from other sources. This aggregate report contains information on agency providers and the demographics on caregivers/children who participated in Triple P programs in Shasta County. This data was entered into the Shasta County Scoring Application reflecting caregivers served through the end of December 2013.

This dashboard report reflects a total of **1462 Triple P caregivers** served in Shasta County, representing **1245 children**.**
