

Emergency Housing Vouchers

The Shasta County Housing Authority (SCHA) received a special allocation of 36 Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV) for the counties of Modoc, Shasta (outside the city limits of Redding), Siskiyou, and Trinity by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The EHVs will provide rental assistance to individuals and families who are experiencing homelessness; at risk of experiencing homelessness; fleeing, or attempting to flee, domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking; or were recently homeless and rental assistance will prevent the individual or family's homelessness or high risk of housing instability.

EHVs are filled through a direct referral process from the Coordinated Entry System and Local Victims Service Providers. Interested applicants that meet the above criteria, including current HCV waiting list applicants, should contact your local [Coordinating Access Points](#) for the counties of Modoc, Shasta, and Siskiyou. For Trinity County contact the Dos Rios Continuum of Care at [Dos Rios Continuum of Care \(cgtcap.org\)](#). SCHA is not able to accept referrals directly from individuals/families and verification of eligibility will be required before a referral can be completed. Once all vouchers are filled, a waiting list will be established by date and time the referral was received to fill future vacancies and will remain open until it is determined by SCHA that a sufficient number of referrals have been received.
