1. Resident stated that another resident stuck him in the back with a pencil. The nurse was called to check the red red mark and the resident stated he was in no pain.
2. Resident was feeling dizzy and was unable to stand properly. She stated she had taken her meds but had not drank water all day. She seemed to hear things that were not there. The nurse came to her room and gave her water. She finally relaxed after drinking more water and was cleared.
3. Resident punched the wall in his room and thought he broke his finger. Three fingers were red, however the nurse stated they were not injured and resident was given a bag of ice.
4. Resident felt dehydrated and the nurse placed her on bed rest and told her to hydrate and that he would check on her in the morning.
5. Resident had a bad rash on her chest and the on-call doctor advised to give her a bag of ice as well as an anti fungal cream to use once a day for 10 days and to follow up with the nurse in the morning.
6. Resident punched his wall and had slight swelling. He was checked and given a bag of ice.
7. Resident punched his door and his pinky was red. The Resident declined medical attention and ice.
8. Resident Punched his mirror and sink and had slight blood on his hand. He was taken to medical where he was was x-rayed. No Fracture was found and he was given Ibuprofen and ice.
9. Resident slipped off his sink and twisted his ankle where he claimed to hear a "pop". The nurse was called and noted he only had a slight bruise on the top of his foot and he was given Ibuprofen and ice.
10. Resident swallowed a minute piece of metal while in the safety cell. He was counseled about the safety of swallowing such an item and advised not to digest the metal. He stated he threw up and it was no longer in his system.
11. **Suicide Ideation:** Resident was heard yelling from his room that he was going to cut his wrists. He then stated he was,"Just fucking with you guys!" He was still taken to booking and was medically checked for a superficial cut on his wrist. He was changed rooms and given saffey blankets, a gown, and mattress.
12. **Suicide Ideation:** Resident was laughing and flooded his room while stating he was suicidal. He also ripped his shirt and placed it around his neck. He was taken to booking anf placed in a smock. He was later cleared by mental health where he returned to his room and went to bed.
13. **Suicide Ideation:** Resident stated he did not feel safe in his room alone, nor did he trust himself. He was taken to a safety cell where he was evaluated by mental health and cleared.
14. **Suicide Ideation:** Resident stated she wanted to hurt herself and she could so using paint chips from her room. After being counseled she made believable commitment that she was going to be ok and not harm herself.

15. **Suicide Ideation:** Resident wanted out of her room and stated she wanted to harm herself. She was instructed to remove all items from her room, including her glasses so she could not harm herself.

16. **Suicide Ideation:** Resident was upset about court and didn't want to be in here room alone. She was counseled and told that her mental health is more important to take care of, where she was allowed to program with others and seemed good after peer time.

17. **Suicide Ideation:** Resident was placed in safety cell per nurse Robert and while being transported refused to comply with orders. Once in booking he refused orders to remove his clothes and dress in a safety gown. He was taken to the ground for non-compliance and informed if he did not comply his clothes would be removed and he would be dressed by officers. He then complied and was checked by mental health where he was cleared.

1. Resident punched the wall in her room. Her hand was swollen and bruised slightly. The nurse advised to give her Tylenol and a bag of ice after assessing her.

2. Resident hit the wall outside and had slight bleeding and redness. She had full mobility of her hand and was given 325mg of non-asprin and a band-aid.

3. Resident was outside when he jumped and fell on his left wrist. The nurse advised to give him 2 non asprin tablets and a bag of soapy ice.

4. Resident fell of his toilet and his hit nose on the floor. It was actively bleeding until he was given a tissue and it instantly stopped. The on-call Dr. ordered the resident be given Ibuprofen twice daily if needed and an ice pack.

5. Resident got into a physical altercation with another resident and both were assessed by the nurse. One resident had a small abrasion to his elbow and a knot on the side of his face.

6. **SUICIDE ATTEMPT:** Resident was holding a ripped blanket around her neck and was refusing to remove it. Officers entered her room, took control of the situation, and transported her to booking. Mental Health came to assess and resident stated it was just anxiety, that she was not trying to harm

6. herself. After being counseled the resident was cleared and returned to her POD.

7. **SUICIDE ATTEMPT:** Resident tied his pillow case around his neck. Officers entered the room and removed the pillowcase. He was taken to a safety cell, given a safety smock, and safety bedding.

8. **SUICIDE ATTEMPT:** Resident was on M.S.R. status and was found with a towel wrapped around his neck. The towel was removed and the resident was taken to booking where he stated, "he was upset that other residents were picking on him." He was put in a transition room and observed by

8. two staff because of his status until mental health came and cleared him.

9. **SUICIDE IDEATION:** Resident stated that he didn't feel safe in his room. He was taken to booking and stated he really just needed someone to talk to. A Wellpath provider came and spoke with him for a bit before clearing him to return to his room.

1. Resident had low blood sugar and was given juice and graham crackers. She then tested normal.

2. Resident made herself hyperventilate and pass out. She fell and hit her head and had a bump. She was checked and given a bag of ice.

3. Resident was in a handstand position and was instructed to get down. While doing so, he slipped and hit his head on the floor. He had a small bump and was given a bag of ice.

4. Resident punched his wall and his right hand was slightly swollen. He was given a packet of non-asprin and declined ice.

5. Resident was seen using paint chips to cut herself. She stated she was in no way suicidal, but was just stressed out and the pain felt good.

6. Resident was playing basketball and heard a pop. His elbow had a noticable bump and looked dislocated. The resident was taken to the Emergency Room where he returned with ibuprofen.

7. Resident was found unresponsive with blood near her and her hands were shaking. She was taken to medical where where the on-call Dr. advised she be taken to the hospital. At the hospital she was placed in soft restraints until she was relased and returned to the facility and placed

7. in a safety cell until mental health was able to assess her in the morning.

8. Resident was observed using a white cup on the rec yard that is used when handing out medication. He stated he had just taken a weeks worth of his pills because it was his birthday and he wanted to die. He was taken to the hospital where they drew blood and monitored him. He was released and

8. placed on suicide watch until mental health was able to come to the facility and clear him.

9. Resident had blood on her arms. She was found to have a wire in her room in which she used to to make a 2-3 inch superficial cut on her arm. Mental Health was called and directed staff to place the resident in a safety gown, given a safety blanket, and placed in a safety cell.

10. Resident stated she was having a hard time being away from her family for the holidays. She said she was having thoughts of hitting her had on the wall until she dies. Mental health was contacted and advised staff to keep an eye on her.

11. Resident said she was having suicidal thoughts and had been writing them down. Resident was counseled and during so she stated at this time she did not want to harm herself and talking it out made her feel better. Her hygiene kit was removed just as a caution for the time being.
