**A. Developing a Comprehensive Juvenile Justice Plan- Community Planning Conversation facilitated by Richard Knecht**

Tracie Neal gave an overview of the Comprehensive Juvenile Justice Plan from March of 1997 to date. The plan was updated in March of 2001. In 2011, Probation received a grant for Best Practices Approach Initiatives Continuous Quality Improvement to help with Juvenile planning. In 2014 Sharon Brisolara was hired as a consultant to develop the Juvenile Probation Evaluation Capacity Building

Report. In 2014-2015, Probation consulted with Samuel Leach of Candor Consulting LLC. to develop a year to year plan to improve evidenced based practices and improve services for our youth.

As a result of the new requirements of the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act and Youthful Offender Block Grant which include development of a comprehensive plan, Probation contracted with Richard Knecht to assist with the plan update.

Tracie introduced Richard Knecht and gave an overview of his experience. She emphasized that everyone's voice is important. She said that she truly wants to know what working, what's not and areas for improvement.

Richard presented a power point presentation of what to expect in today's meeting in laying out the ground work for the Comprehensive Juvenile Justice Pan and the group identified other community partners who should also have input on the planning that were not at the meeting.

The attendees worked in groups discussion to answer questions on Outcomes, Challenges, Opportunities Assessment, Strengths Assessments, and Threats Assessments Tool.

Richard asked for anyone who would like to have a one on one conversation with him to have a voice in the process either by email or phone to include their information on the signup sheet.

Richard indicated that he will use information provided at the meeting and future interviews to develop a draft of the Comprehensive Juvenile Justice Plan. The group will reconvene following the completion of a draft of the plan to review and discuss the results.
