NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, at their regularly scheduled meeting on June 14, 2022, at 8:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Board Chambers located at 1450 Court Street, Suite 263, Redding, California, the Shasta County Air Pollution Control Board, County of Shasta, State of California, will hold a public hearing for the following items:

Application by the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) for transfer of banked Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs), owned by PG&E, from the Shasta County Air Quality Management District ERC Bank to the Tehama County Air Pollution Control District. The total amount of ERCs requested to be transferred is equal to 7,500 pounds/calendar quarter of oxides of nitrogen (NOx) emissions.
