However, I am writing to inform you that, at this time and after reviewing the reports you sent us, the Wintu Tribe is still opposed to your project moving forward in Wintu territory. As stated before, the described project in your proposal will have extreme negative effects which will result in destruction in sensitive historical and cultural sites that can never be replaced. The ramifications would be detrimental and irreversible.

Unfortunately, at this time, we cannot support your project and we request that no excavations or other ground disturbing activities of any kind take place in the project area or we will be bound to pursue a Seize and Desist order which will be attained to use against the project.
