## Safe Sharps Disposal

- DO** put used sharps in a puncture-proof container with a tight lid.
- DO** secure the lid with duct tape.
- DO** label the container as "SHARPS".
- DO** keep the container away from children and pets.
- DO** dispose of the container properly.

**DO NOT** throw sharps in trash, recycle or green waste bins!
